

CROSSING THE THAMES

There are five options for new or improved pedestrian and cycle crossing of the Thames:

CAVERSHAM BRIDGE (CT1): A separate 'cantilevered' bridge* attached to Caversham Bridge.

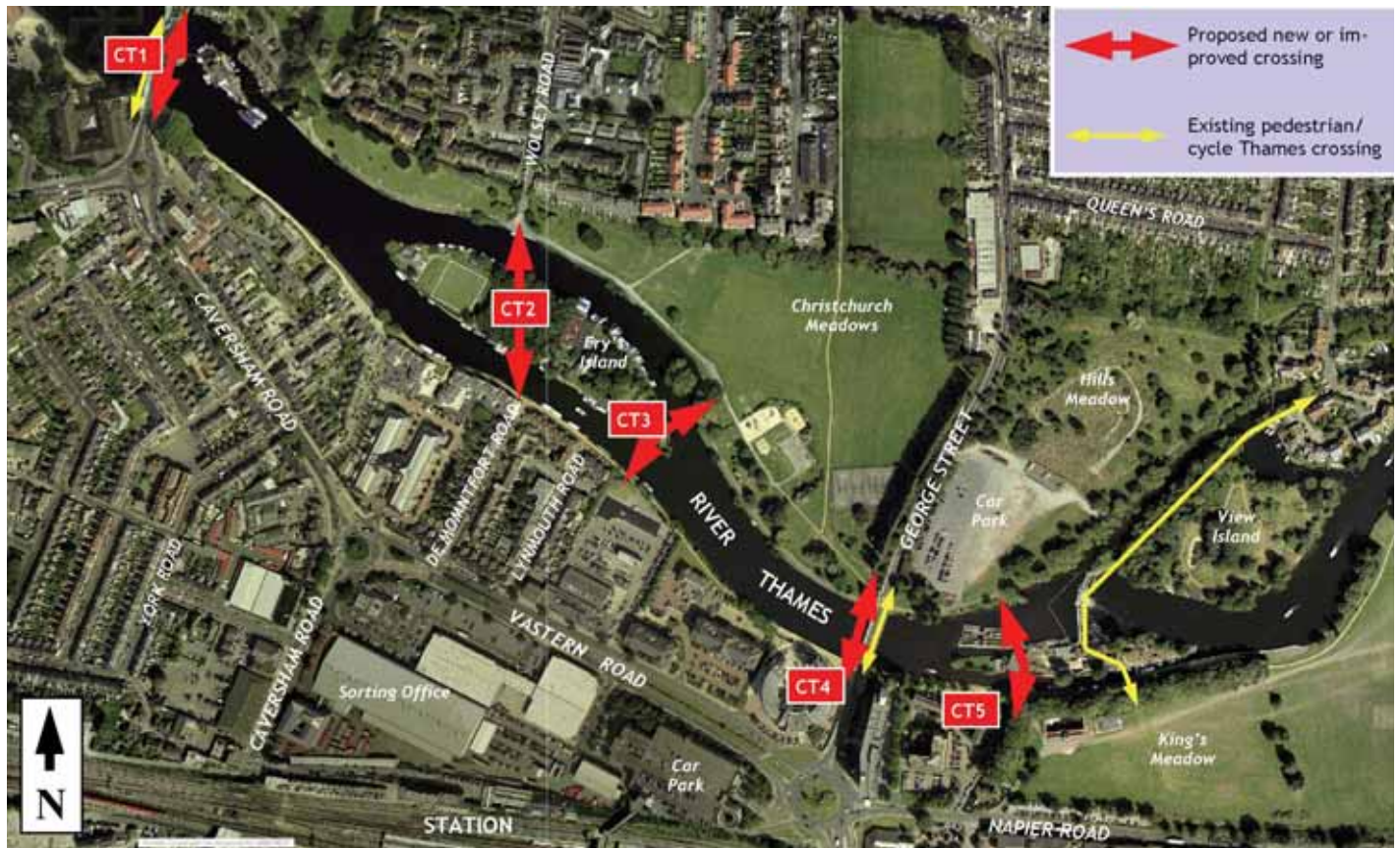
WOLSEY ROAD (CT2): A new bridge would link De Montfort Road and Wolsey Road.

CHRISTCHURCH MEADOWS (CT3): A bridge would cross the river between the existing electricity depot on Vastern Road and Christchurch Meadows.

READING BRIDGE (CT4): A separate 'cantilevered' bridge* attached to Reading Bridge.

CAVERSHAM LOCK (CT5): A new bridge would link Kings Meadow with Hills Meadow via Caversham Lock.

* A 'cantilevered bridge' is a bridge partly supported by another structure
